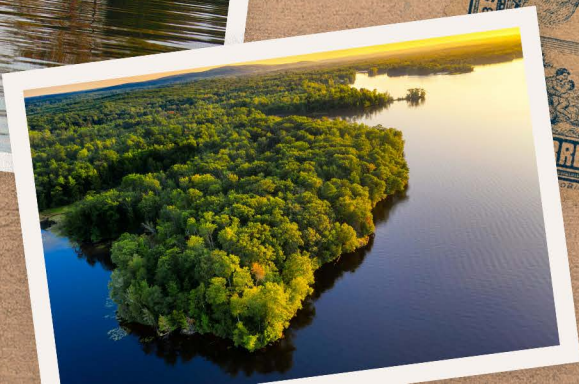

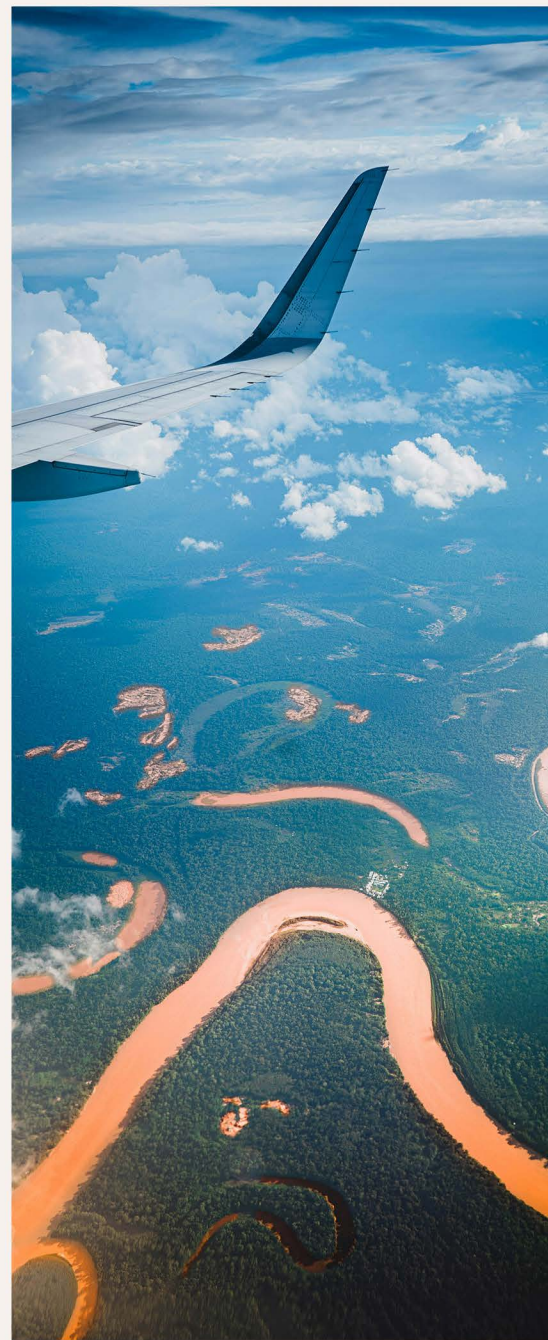


Greetings from Tennessee!

We're so excited that you're joining us on this incredible journey deep into the heart of the Brazilian Amazon! There's no way to describe the wonder and purpose of this trip until you've experienced it for yourself, but we can say this: the Lord always moves powerfully on the waters of the Amazon.

We're full of expectation for how God will not only transform lives in the villages we visit, but also how He will work in your life through this adventure. This team has been divinely assembled for a reason, and we can't wait to see how the Lord uses each of you as we go together into the jungle!

This packet will walk you through everything you need to know as you prepare for the trip - logistics, travel details, and the heart behind Far-Flung Tin Can's work in the Amazon region.



Why the Amazon?

Since 2016, Far-Flung Tin Can has partnered with the remote river village of Terranova, a vibrant and growing community nestled deep within the Brazilian rainforest. What began as a single connection has grown into a lasting relationship built on discipleship, practical help, and the consistent message of Jesus' love.

Every year, our team sails nearly 500 miles downriver to reach Terranova and other unreached or underserved villages along the Amazon. The journey itself takes about two days by boat each way, passing through lush jungle, winding tributaries, and village communities along the riverbanks.

During our time on the water and in the villages, we have seen God open doors in unexpected ways – from divine encounters with fishermen, boat repair crews, and families along the river to powerful moments of worship in the most remote settings imaginable. These “in-between” moments are often where the Holy Spirit moves most profoundly.

Our work in the Amazon includes:

Village Ministry: Sharing the Gospel through preaching, prayer, and relationship building.

Discipleship: Encouraging and equipping local believers in their faith.

Partnership with Terranova: Continuing the long-term work we've built with this beautiful community since 2016.

Spontaneous Evangelism: Responding to divine appointments along the river as we travel

Each trip is a blend of adventure, faith, and transformation, not just for those we minister to, but for every team member who steps aboard.

Nuts and Bolts

With any mission trip, there's a lot of information to go over before we depart. This packet will give you everything you need to start preparing well in advance so that when the time comes, you're ready, physically, spiritually, and mentally, for all God has in store.





Packing Guidelines

Here are some essentials you'll want to bring for life on the boat and in the villages:

- + **Lightweight, breathable clothing:** Quick-dry shirts, shorts, and pants – it's hot and humid in the jungle!
- + **Rain jacket or poncho:** Expect tropical downpours.
- + **Waterproof sandals or shoes:** Something sturdy for muddy paths and boat decks.
- + **Toiletries & Towel:** Compact, travel-friendly items. Showers are simple and sometimes limited. Dude Wipes are a great addition to your toiletries bag!
- + **Sunscreen & Sunglasses:** The equatorial sun is no joke.
- + **Bug Repellent:** A must-have for jungle environments.
- + **Personal Medicine & First Aid Kit:** Be sure to pack any daily medications in their original containers so you can avoid complications at the airport.
- + **Bible & Journal:** Besides your passport, this may be the most important thing to bring with you. We foresee the Lord downloading all sorts of things in you during this trip, and you're going to want to write down and record those things. We also want you to come equipped and prepared – don't leave your Sword at home.
- + **Portable Charger:** Electricity can be limited on the boat.
- + **Passport:** Keep it secure and accessible for travel at all times!
- + **Money:** Bring cash for snacks, coffee, or souvenirs during travel days. There will be places to exchange at the airports and after we land!





Suggested Vaccinations

We recommend checking with a travel clinic for the most up-to-date vaccine guidance for the Amazon region. Commonly suggested vaccines include Tetanus, Hepatitis A & B, DTaP, and Yellow Fever. Always follow professional medical advice based on your personal health and travel history.

Allergies

If you have any allergies – food, environmental, or medical – please let us know ASAP. This helps us plan meals, groceries, and accommodations with your safety in mind. Bring any allergy medications or EpiPens with you (labeled in your name) and keep them in an easily accessible place.
